Program Overview

- **AIR FORCE ROTC**

- 4-year program designed to train & evaluate future officers in the United States Air Force & Space Force
 - 3-year & 5-year programs also available
- The program is demanding and fast-paced, with cadets training toward leading airmen and learning how to execute the Air Force & Space Force missions

- **COURSE WORK**

- Cadets in the program will take an Aerospace Studies course, a Leadership Lab, and will attend Fitness Training several times a week (discussed later)





Admission Requirements



- **ACADEMIC**

- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (12+ credit hours per term) at:
 - Fresno State
 - Fresno City College
 - Clovis Community College
 - Reedley College
 - Merced College
 - College of the Sequoias
- If you have previously taken college-level courses, you must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0



- **FITNESS**

- Be in good physical condition and able to pass a Physical Fitness Assessment once per semester
 - 1.5 mile run
 - Push-ups
 - Sit-ups

Admission Requirements

- **MEDICAL**

- All cadets must meet Department of Defense Medical Examination & Review Board (DoDMERB) criteria

- **CITIZENSHIP**

- Must be able to obtain citizenship no later than the end of cadet's junior year





Scholarships



- **COVERAGE**

- Full tuition/fees at Fresno State or any of our crosstown schools
- \$900 a year for books
- Monthly stipend
 - Freshman: \$300
 - Sophomore: \$350
 - Junior: \$450
 - Senior: \$500



- **ELIGIBILITY**

- Have at or above a 3.0 Term GPA (from last term) & 2.5 Cumulative GPA
- Be DoDMERB (medically) qualified
- Pass the Air Force Fitness Assessment

Classes



- **ALL STUDENTS**

- Leadership Lab (ASP 3)
 - 1 credit, 1 hour 50 minutes
- Fitness Training
 - 2-3 times per week, 60 minutes each

- **FRESHMAN**

- Heritage & Values (ASP 1A/B)
 - 1 credit, 1 hour 15 minutes

- **SOPHOMORE**

- Team & Leadership Fundamentals (ASP 2A/B)
 - 1 credit, 1 hour 15 minutes



Dual enrolled sophomores take ASP 1A/B & 2A/B concurrently



Classes



- **JUNIOR**

- Field Training (ASP 103)
 - 3 credits, ~2 weeks over the Summer
- Leading People & Effective Communication (ASP 104A/B)
 - 3 credits, 3 hours



- **SENIOR**

- National Security, Leadership Responsibilities, & Commissioning Preparation (ASP 105A/B)
 - 3 credits, 3 hours
